

# Oklahoma Star Mentoring Program

The official mentoring program of the Miss Oklahoma Organization, Inc.

A mentoring program for young ladies ages five (5) to ten (10). To be mentored by a Local Miss Candidate and to also join in on a fun-filled week during the Miss Oklahoma Competition.

1. Introduce young girls to the Miss Oklahoma & Miss America Organizations, which is one of the largest scholarship assistance programs in the world. In fact, the Miss Oklahoma Scholarship Foundation awards over \$125,000 in scholarships and awards each summer.
2. Have the opportunity to represent one of our Miss Oklahoma Local Titleholders and be mentored by her titleholder during her reign. To gain personal growth.
3. Enjoy a special week while her Miss candidate is vying for the title of Miss Oklahoma. The week will be an incredible opportunity for your daughter to accompany her candidate on stage, be part of a special production, and learn poise, grace and confidence.
4. Each Oklahoma Star will represent a specific Miss titleholder. If your daughter doesn't have a titleholder, we will match her with one. Each Oklahoma Star will appear on-stage the night her titleholder has Evening Wear and again in a special production during the Final Show on Saturday, June 6. When not performing, she will sit with her parent or guardian to watch the show.
5. To have fun and make new friendships!

Miss Oklahoma Competition week takes place May 31-June 6 in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the River Spirit Casino Resort.

The **\$490 Registration Fee** provides your Oklahoma Star with the following:

- Official Miss Oklahoma Star Crown.
- Photo and name in the Miss Oklahoma Competition Magazine (Program Book).
- Participation in an on-stage production number during the final show of Miss Oklahoma 2020.
- Introduction on stage during one night of preliminary competition with her candidate.
- The Oklahoma Star and her Parent or Guardian will receive tickets for all shows of the Miss Oklahoma competition. Additional tickets may be purchased (more information to follow in March).
- Receive two Official Badges to attend rehearsals and nightly visitations.
- Receive official Oklahoma Star T-shirt and bag.
- Attend a special luncheon with her candidate.
- Attend the Oklahoma Star Party.

## Crowns:

**New Oklahoma Stars:** Your Oklahoma Star will receive her official Oklahoma Star crown on April 4<sup>th</sup>, if she attends the Miss Oklahoma Spring Meeting/Talent Day. If you are not able to attend April 4<sup>th</sup> your OK Star will receive her crown when she registers for the week of Miss Oklahoma.

**Returning Oklahoma Stars:** If you have been an Oklahoma Star within the past 3 years then you do not need to order a new Star Crown. However, if your crown is lost or broken, then yes, you will need to order a new crown.

## Requirements for Participation:

- **Age requirement:** Applicants must be between the ages of 5 and 10 as of March 1, 2020.
- **Participation fee:** The Registration Fee is \$490 for a new Oklahoma Star and a returning Oklahoma Star is \$430 (if already has official OK Star crown). Your payment must be paid/mailed by March 13, 2020.
- **Participation requirements:** Our Oklahoma Stars are expected to:
  - Attend the morning rehearsal and preliminary show the day your titleholder has Red Carpet (also known as Evening Wear) Competition.
  - Attend set rehearsals for the on-stage production number.
- **Wardrobe requirements:**
  - Competition Attire:**
    - Dressy, SOLID WHITE dress (any style or type of fabric) and no other color on the dress. No dresses with lots of petticoats. If dress has sash, bows, appliqués, buttons, etc. they MUST be white, silver, or clear. Sparkles/stones must be clear or silver and at a minimum (dress must be primarily white). The hem must fall between the knee and the ankle and must NOT touch the floor.
    - Shoes to wear with white dress: must be white, silver, or clear (age appropriate). For safety concerns, the shoes should be secure when walking, climbing stairs, etc. (no slides/slip-on or backless).  
Rehearsal or Daytime Attire:
  - Casual Attire:** Shorts, Capris, jeans, casual skirt or dress, workout wear, etc. Bring a sweater or jacket because the air-conditioning can be cool.
    - T-shirts will be provided for 2 days – lunch with her candidate and the OK Star Party.
  - Crown:** Must wear **official** Oklahoma Star crown only.
- **Photo Requirement: One head & shoulder (wallet to 5x7) high resolution COLOR photograph 300 dpi.**
  - If using a cell phone photo – the photo must be high resolution – check your settings
  - Please send full image of head & shoulder photo – no photos with top of the head cropped off or face only photos
  - This is your official photograph so should reflect age-appropriate clothing
  - No strapless dresses, glitz, hats, CROWNS, flowers, trophies, etc.
  - Must be submitted electronically with Oklahoma Stars name and local organization name identifying photo.
  - If submitting a professional photograph, you must submit a photo release from the photographer. School photos do not require a photo release.
  - Deadline for Photo is March 13, 2020.

## Additional Miss Oklahoma Details

**Miss Oklahoma Spring Meeting & Talent Revue:** Scheduled for Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. This day is when all of the local titleholders and directors gather to meet each other and to obtain information about the week of Miss Oklahoma. In the morning each Miss candidate will perform her talent that she will present during the week of Miss Oklahoma and we invite the Oklahoma Stars to attend the talent session if she would like. This is not required but is a fun event. Additional information will be sent later.

**Tickets & Badges:** Each Oklahoma Star will receive Miss Oklahoma show tickets and badges for herself and for one parent or guardian. Additional Competition tickets and badges for family and friends are available to purchase. Additional information on tickets will be distributed in March.

**Housing:** All Oklahoma Stars, their families and friends are responsible for their own housing and meals during competition week. Competition Headquarters Hotel reservations can be secured through River Spirit Casino Resort – located at 8330 Riverside Parkway, Tulsa, OK. The Miss Oklahoma rate is \$109. Per night plus taxes. **Communication:** You will receive emails regarding any announcements or instructions. Make sure the email address we have for you is one you check regularly, even on the weekend (not a work email address). Expect to receive emails even during competition week.

**Schedule:** Make sure you are available to be in Tulsa during Miss Oklahoma week of June 1-6. A more detailed schedule will be announced closer to competition week.

## Salute Page Ads

The following is a brief description about the Salute Page Ads. Also, each titleholder has been mailed a complete packet of information regarding this campaign. If you have questions, your titleholder can give you more details and show you samples or feel free to contact our office.

**What is a Salute Page Ad?** It is an advertisement page in our official program book. The Salute Page Ad is a wonderful way for hometown businesses, friends, family and relatives to show their support to you and your titleholder.

**What is the cost for a full page?** A full-page black & white ad is \$350. or full-page color ad is \$750. Each page can have one sponsor or several sponsors.

**How many people will view this ad?** Thousands of people will see the ad not only in Oklahoma but Kansas, Texas, Arkansas, Missouri, and throughout the entire country!

### **What do I do if I want to purchase a page(s)?**

- a. Contact your titleholder and let her know the number of pages you would like to purchase. She has all of the paperwork and details on preparing your page.
- b. Have your titleholder complete the order form & salute page checklist.
- c. Give your titleholder your check for the designated amount due per ad page.
- d. Select photo(s) to be used on page(s) and give to your titleholder.  
It is always fun to have your photo with your titleholder in the program. Make sure your name is on the CD or back of your photo.

**What is the deadline for the ads?** All ads, checks, and paperwork must be turned in no later than Spring Meeting/Talent Day - Saturday, April 4, 2020.

**Color ads:** 300dpi, 4 Color Process, and sized at 8.75 x 11.25 with bleed

**B/W ads:** 300dpi, grayscale and sized at 8.75 x 11.25 with bleed

**Fonts:** Along with artwork, all fonts must be converted to outlines, or all fonts used in ad must be supplied
